Altar of the Dead

Every item on our Day of the Dead altar, or the Día de los Muertos altar, at the front of the church has a special significance. Our altar features marigolds, perforated paper flags, lit candles, glasses of water, and portraits of our beloved deceased. This week, we will discuss portraits, marigolds, and the flags.

The portraits are the most important component of these altars. They are a vital way for us to remember our beloved dead, and honor their memory in a special way. It is also traditionally believed that displaying the pictures tells our loved ones that it is time to visit.

Marigolds, or cempasúchil, are favored for the altars as it is believed that their strong fragrance attracts the spirits of our loved ones. The color orange is also associated with celebrating life, rather than focusing on the sadness of death.

The colored flags of perforated papers, or papel picado, are associated with the wind. It is said that the holes give our deceased loved ones a path of travel back by. These days, many flags are purchased in bulk, but in private homes they often cut the flags by hand.
